MARCH BREAK CAMP
POLICIES AND GUIDELINES

Campers will need to bring:

Shoe or Boot with a minimum half inch heel for riding.

Full Length Pant for riding.

Weather Appropriate clothing & foot wear.

ASTM approved helmets are mandatory and are available
for use during camp week for \$20.

Lunch, drinks and snacks. We do have a vending machine on site with
water, pop, hot drinks and treats.

There is also a fridge and microwave and heated lunch area available
to campers.

Camp will run regardless of weather. Indoor riding facilities will be used
during inclement weather.

Please initial the attendance form kept by the Senior Counselor to indicate
the time and date of drop off /pick up for your child. Please contact the
office if your child is unable to attend on any day of camp. Please advise
the office if there is someone other than yourself picking your child up.

Drop off is no earlier than 8:20am and pick is at 4:00pm. Additional su-
pervision may be arranged ahead of time at a rate of \$10/half hour paid
directly to the supervising counselor.

Refunds are available on the camp week if written notice of cancellation
is received before 9am of the second day. Refund amount will be for
remaining camp days minus a \$50 administration fee. Cancellation due to
medical reasons - administration fee waived.

Waiver forms, contact information, and polices forms must be filled out
by the parent or legal guardian of minors before registration is accepted.
All riders do so at their own risk.

Parents, Friends and Family members are encouraged to attend the Friday
show that runs every week for the campers. Feel free to bring cameras and
video equipment if you like. Dogs must be kept on a leash.

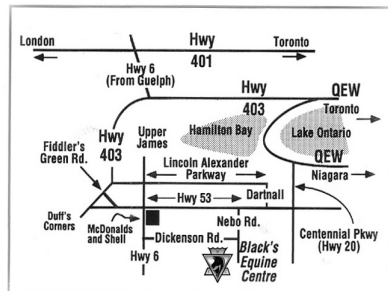
We are home to over 75 horses, offer four indoor riding arenas, three outdoor rings and over ninety acres of trails.
